










- a) Deactivate power in the circuit which the luminaire is going to be connected to.
 b) Carefully take the luminaire out of the package.
 c) Ceiling mounting:

 cut out an installation hole in the ceiling with the dimensions given in the box above,
 - tilt back the plate with the connection block,
 - pull the feeding cable through the gland,
 - connect the feeding cable as indicated on the connection block,
 - tilt back the springs on the sides of the luminaire and install the device in the ceiling.
