### 1. Dimensions

#### 2. Assembly

- a) carefully take the fixture out of box and put it on a stable surface (table, floor)
- b) take off the frame with a plate ATTENTION! Frame has been installed on a magnets, to take it off pull

it strongly and unbuckle hook protecting the frame

- c) connection of power supply
- pull the feeding cable through the hole in the base of a fixture
- connect the wires as shown on a cube





- fixture is installed to the ceiling through four 6,5mm holes of 500x500mm spread
- e) suspended mounting:
- screw line regulators into 4 holes spaced 400x500mm
- screw universal suspension on to the ceiling
- delicately loosen regulator's outer nut, push the line in until the desired suspension

height and tighten the nut. Putting line into the regulator will result with lifting of a fixture

To lower the fixture loosen the regulator's outer nut and push it towards the fixture – line will start coming out

- f) mounting in the suspended ceiling
- cut the hole of size 605x605 mm
- put the mounting frame in an screw the mounting holders on
- screw the base of a fixture to the mounting frame through four 6,5mm holes of 500x500mm spread
- g) fasten the hook and close the fixture


